





2006 750 ml	Brut - Volupté Cru 1er Cru A pretty and attractively complex nose of yeast, green apple and pear aromas introduces delicious and softly round flavors that culminate in a finish that I would describe as barely off dry. This well-balanced effort also possesses a relatively fine mousse while delivering fine length and reasonably good depth as well.	Oct 15, 2013	<u>90</u>
2006 750 ml	Brut - Empreinte Cru 1er Cru There is plenty of yeast and brioche character to the citrus and green apple scents. The intense and agreeably crisp flavors are supported by a relatively fine mousse before terminating a finish that is markedly drier than the Volupté. In a word, lovely. Note that this could easily be held for further development and I suspect doing so will enhance what is already a very yeasty flavor profile.	Oct 15, 2013	<u>91</u>
-NV- 750 ml	Brut - Expression Cru 1er Cru A pretty and elegant mix of citrus, floral, lemon zest and soft yeast aromas. There is good vibrancy and detail to the moderately complex and attractively dry middle weight flavors that offer reasonably good length. I like this but it lacks just a bit of depth but I do like the clean and focused finish. This could be enjoyed now or held for a few years first.	Oct 15, 2013	89

-NV- 750 ml	Brut - Rosé de Saignée Cru 1er Cru	Oct 15, 2013	<u>91</u>
	Deep rosé color. An exuberantly fruity nose of strawberry, raspberry and cherry leads to utterly delicious, intense and well-detailed flavors that are supported by a moderately firm mousse that possesses a relatively fine bead, particularly for a rosé, all wrapped in a clean and agreeably dry finish that exudes a subtle saline character. This is really lovely as it's both bracing and refreshing plus it displays fine depth. This could be enjoyed now or held for a few years first.
